Regularly Scheduled Events

Chess Club- Whether you want to learn the game or hone your skills come join us for the game of kings! Open to ages 5-105. All skill levels welcome.

Cinema Kitsch—A monthly movie series showing cheesy fan favorites and making good-natured jokes while we watch. We will also have drawing supplies for those who want to sketch along with the on screen antics. Age 16 & up.

Comics Appreciation Group—A gathering for fans of sequential art, getting together to talk about their favorite comics, modern and classic, mainstream and indie. A great time to learn about new comics and pass on recommendations to others. Age 16 & up.

First Friday Book Club— A monthly book discussion for adults. This month's title is *The Burning Room* by Michael Connelly.

Gaming Social—An afternoon of board, card, and tabletop games. We will have the PCL game library on hand, but encourage attendees to bring any favorites they want to share. Age 16 & Up

Kids Draw—Free draw session open to all ages. Materials provided. Children under age 10 must be accompanied by an adult.

Lego Club—Ages 5 and Up (Strict, due to small parts) We provide the blocks, you provide the creativity. Children under age 10 must remain accompanied by an adult.

Read!Play!Grow! - Ages birth-3 years. Part baby bounce, part literacy minded play, part early literacy education, and a whole lotta fun!

Story Time with Mrs. Donovan— Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays at 10am in the Story Time Room.

Teen Creator Space—We provide the tools, you provide the imagination. A place to make things and hang out with others who enjoy doing the same. Open to ages 12-17.

Teen Gaming Club— Play cards, conquer kingdoms, and outwit friends! Retro video games provided. Open to teens ages 12-17.

Teen Hangout—Teens are invited to come hang out, watch a movie, and play games in the Downstairs Meeting Room.

Teen Sketch Club— All teens and all abilities welcome! Enjoy sharing sketches and art games.

Twice Told Tales Book Sale— Used book sale hosted by the Putnam County Library Friends. Proceeds benefit the library.

Upper Cumberland Community Meditation Program—It's time to center yourself and bring mindfulness into your life. Join us for a guided meditation every second Wednesday of the month as we explore the inner recesses of our own minds and leave all our stress behind us. You will thank yourself afterwards.

Special Events

Computer Classes— Free classes covering a range of computer topics. Space is limited to 6 students per session, first come first serve. Ages 18 & up.

Family Movie Night—Come by for an all-ages movie on the library projection screen. This month: *The Little Vampire* PG

Financial FAQs—A monthly informational seminar presented by local investment planner Landon Vick. Free to attend, open to all, refreshments provided. This month: Estate Planning 101 – Understanding the basics of estate planning and what steps to take and to avoid in planning your estate.

Homeschool Hangout—A place for kids to come hangout, work on different skills, and have some fun! Recommended for preschool aged children and up.

Preschool Crafts—A drop in session of fun kids crafts, starting just as soon as Story Time wraps up.

Sensory Story Time—An interactive and educational program that can be enjoyed by all children, but is especially designed for young children with sensory integration challenges. Recommended for preschool aged children.

Teen Book Club—A book club tailored to teen tastes, for ages 14-18. Copies of the month's book will be available beforehand at the Front Desk, come discuss your favorite (and least favorite) parts and join in on a themed activity. This month: *The Graveyard Book* by Neil Gaiman.
